Application Process for WYM Camp Scholarship Program

The general aim of this scholarship fund is to make it possible for people with very limited personal/family financial resources who are members or attenders of meetings in *Western Yearly Meeting* to participate in *Western Yearly Meeting* camps held at Quaker Haven.

Who may apply? Any person who is a member or attender of a local meeting of *Western Yearly Meeting* who is in need of financial assistance to attend a *Western Yearly Meeting* -sponsored camp at Quaker Haven.

Each applicant must be recommended by **one** of the following: the pastor, assistant pastor, Monthly Meeting clerk, CM&E (Ministry & Counsel) Clerk, CE Committee Clerk, Sunday school teacher, Sunday school superintendent, or youth worker of his or her meeting. (Any of the above persons may also submit an application on behalf of a person who is a member or attender of a local meeting of *Western Yearly Meeting*.)

The Board on Christian Education expects that applicants will pay at least a small portion of the cost of the camp and that the local monthly meeting, or an auxiliary group of the meeting (*e.g.*, youth group, Sunday school, USFW, or Quaker Men), will contribute financially to the applicant's camp costs before application is made to the *Western Yearly Meeting* Camp Scholarship Fund.

Application process: Pastors, assistant pastors, Monthly Meeting clerks, CM&E (Ministry & Counsel) clerks, CE Committee Clerks, Sunday school teachers, Sunday school superintendents, and youth workers of Monthly Meetings of *Western Yearly Meeting* may recommend qualified people. Applicants may ask any of the above listed in their meeting to recommend them, **or** any of the above listed may recommend an applicant. **The recommending person is responsible for sending the application to the yearly meeting office.** Application forms are available from the yearly meeting office or on the *Western Yearly Meeting* website (www.westernym.net).

How are recipients selected? The Christian Ed. Board of *Western Yearly Meeting* will select recipients based on the criteria listed below and the limits of the finances available for the year.

- ◆ Applicants have financial need beyond what they, their family, and their meeting can provide.
- ◆ Effort will be made to provide assistance to individuals attending each of the different camps sponsored by *Western Yearly Meeting* at Quaker Haven.
- ◆ Applications must be postmarked by the deadline on the application form to be considered.
- ◆ Effort will be made to provide assistance to individuals from a variety of meetings.
- ◆ First-time campers at Quaker Haven will be given preference.
- ◆ The main goal is to provide for as many people as possible to be able financially to attend *Western Yearly Meeting* camps based on the amount of funds available each year.

Applications must be postmarked no later than April 30, 2010. Applicants can expect to get a response from the committee by May 21 2010.
